STATE OF PUNJAB Vs Ribjeet Singh

Present: Mrs. Anju Sharma, Addl. PP for the State.  
Accused Ribjeet Singh declared proclaimed offender.  
Accused Suraj Kumar absent.

Non bailable warrants issued to accused Suraj Kumar received back. unexecuted. Perusal of file shows that since 13.03.2025, accused Suraj Kumar is absented and his bail order was canceled and his bail bonds and surety bonds were canceled and forfeited to the State and non bailable warrants of accused Suraj Kumar were issued but the same received back unexecuted several times. This court has reason to believe that accused Suraj Kumar is concealing himself so that warrant cannot be executed. So, accused Suraj Kumar is ordered to be summoned through proclamation under section 84 of BNSS for 31.08.2026. Ahlmad is directed to issue the proclamation within five working days from today and further serving official is directed that this proclamation be published within next seven days and report of proclamation be awaited for date fixed.

Notice issued to surety of accused Suraj Kumar received back unserved. Since, accused Suraj Kumar is absented from the court without any intimation and surety Paramjit Singh who stood surety of accused Suraj Kumar has not appeared and failed to produce the

accused Suraj Kumar in the court, so surety Paramjit Singh is held guilty under Section 491 BNSS. So recovery proceedings against surety Paramjit Singh be initiated. Ahlmad is directed to issue the warrant of attachment of property of surety Paramjit Singh of amount which he furnished the surety of accused Suraj Kumar through Collector and intimation be sent to Collector for initiating proceedings as per section 85 of BNSS (83 Cr.P.C) for date fixed.
