(n) **Let a copy of this judgment be sent to the Id. District Magistrate, Bankura, as well as, to the defacto complainant through Ranibandh P.S. in terms of the decision of Hon’ble High Court at Calcutta dated 29.03.2022 in **Sabitri Bhunya vs. State of West Bengal and others (CRA 266 OF 2020/ CRAN 1 of 2020)**.**
