

Heard learned counsel appearing for plaintiff on IA II filed Under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 of C.P.C praying for ex-parte ad-interim order of injunction restrain the defendants, their servants, agents from publishing, sharing or sending any kind of message, video, audio defaming the plaintiff or cause injury to reputation of plaintiff through face

book, whatsapp or such other social media till disposal of suit. Perused the plaint averments, the contents of IA.No.II and the grounds urged in the supporting affidavit in the light of documents placed on record. Perused the decisions relied upon by the counsel for plaintiff in support of his contention.

The material placed on record reveals the existence of prima-facie case in favour of plaintiff at this stage. As such, if the opponents/defendants are not restrained from sharing or sending any kind of message, video, audio through face book, whatsapp or such other social media by defaming the plaintiff, she will be put great hardship, on other, no hardship would be caused to the defendants. Hence, at this stage, I feel it is just and necessary to grant ex-parte T.I order against the opponents/defendants by dispensing with notice to the opponents as provided U/o. 39 Rule 3 of CPC. Accordingly, I proceed to pass the following.

ORDER

The opponents/defendants, their men, agents, servants are hereby restrained from publish, share or send any kind of message, video, audio defaming the plaintiff or cause injury to reputation of plaintiff through face book, whatsapp or such other social media till their appearance.

The ad-interim injunction order shall in force till the appearance of the defendants.

The plaintiff shall comply the provisions of Order 39 Rule 3(a) of CPC.

Issue ex-parte order of T.I., notice of IA.I and suit summons to the defendants, returnable by:05-10-2020.

At this stage, in order to protect and preserve the suit schedule property, I feel it just and necessary to grant exparte T.I against the opponent/defendant by dispensing with notice of I.A.No.II to the opponent as provided U/o. 39 Rule 3 of CPC. Accordingly, I proceed to pass the following.

ORDER

The opponent/defendant is hereby restrained from alienating or encumbering the plaint 'A' schedule property, till next date of hearing.

The plaintiff shall comply the provisions of Order 39 Rule 3(a) of CPC.

alleged in the supporting affidavit of IA.II, the
purpose of filing this application will be defeated by
delay and plaintiff will be put to irreparable loss
and hardship. At this stage, in order to protect and
preserve the suit property in status-quo, I feel it
just and necessary to grant exparte I.I against the
defendant by dispensing with notice of I.A.II to the
defendant as provided U/o. 39 Rule 3 of CPC.
Accordingly, I proceed to pass the following.

ORDER

The defendant-Village Panchayath and all
persons claiming through it are hereby restrained from
dispossessing the plaintiff from the plaint 'A' schedule
property till next date of hearing.

The plaintiff shall comply the provisions of
Order 39 Rule 3(a) of CPC.
