Chief Examination by Sri. Advocate for Petitioner.

I have filed my affidavit in lieu of my examination-in-chief and the contents of the said affidavit are true and correct and it bears my signature.

Today I have produced the following documents in support of the case:

Cross examination by Sri. Advocate for R.1.

It is true to suggest that I have assessed the disability within six months of the accident. It is true to suggest that during examination, the implant was still present in petitioner. I am not aware whether patient took follow up treatment as advised by his doctor. It is true to suggest that as per Ex.P.8, discharge summary the patient was advised to review to 08.02.2018. I am not aware whether patient went to Kims hospital on the said day for review. Now I see Ex.P.9, OPD card. It is true to suggest that as per the document he must have gone trice for follow up. It is true to suggest that as per the second follow up Ex.P.9, it is mentioned the “wounds are healed.” Now I see the third follow up OPD card, Ex.P.9. It is true to suggest that the patient did not complain in Ex.P.9 dt:19.04.2018 any of the difficulties as mentioned by me in para.3 of my affidavit.

It is true to suggest that as per Ex.P.25, the fractures are united. It is false to suggest that I am bound to take 1/3rd of 36% for whole body. I have taken 50%. It is false to suggest that my assessment is exaggerated in order to enrich the petitioner with higher compensation. It is true to suggest that the driver can drive the vehicle. The witness volunteers that he made drive with difficulties and the disabilities directly effects his avocation. It is true to suggest that I did not state about avocation disability in my affidavit. In the Govt hospital the surgery may cost Rs.15,000. It is false to suggest that since I did not treat the petitioner and incompetent to assess the disability.
