

Heard Sri. K.V.K. Advocate for plaintiff on I.A.II filed Under Order XXXIX Rules 1 & 2 and Section 151 of C.P.C.

Perused the I.A., plaint averments and the documents placed on record with the grounds urged in the supporting affidavit. The plaintiff prays to grant a temporary injunction restraining the opponent/1st defendant, his men, agents, servants and all persons claiming through or under him from committing trespass into the plaint 'A' schedule property or from cutting, or removing any tree existing in the plaint 'A' schedule property or in any way from causing loss or damage to the said property till disposal of this application. On perusal of the same, at this stage, it appears that it is necessary to hear other side before passing an ad-interim injunction order against the defendant No.1. Hence, under the fact and circumstances of the case, it is just and proper to issue emergent notice. Hence issue emergent notice on I.A.No.II and suit summons to the defendants returnable by: 20.11.2025.
