1. Ld. Counsel for the Complainant has submitted the E-filing records of the complainant and appears that the complaint has been filed with a delay of 11 days. An application for condonation is **already on record.**

2. Ld. Counsel for the Complainant has submitted the MCA records of the accused company reflecting the name of accused Nos. 2 & 3 as MDs.

3. Ld. Counsel for the Complainant has relied upon the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in *Kirshna Texport Vs. Ila A. Agrawal* to argue that notice on the complainant shall be deemed to be notice on the Directors as well and casual requirement of issuing a separate notice to all the directors u/s 138 NI Act.

4. Considering the above, let notice of the application seeking condonation of delay be issued to the proposed accused on filing of PF/RC, returnable for the NDOH.
