This Petition was filed on 23-02-2024 and registered on 14-03-2024 by the above named Petitioners under Section 166 of M.V. Act of 1988, praying for compensation of ₹20,00,000/- from the respondents, for the injuries sustained by the petitioner, in an accident caused while travelling as passenger in Mini Bus bearing No. KA-40/A-0362 owned by the respondent No.1 at Someshwara Ghat, 1st Cross, Nadapalu Village, Hebri Taluk, Udupi District on 01-03-2023 at about 5.00 pm.

This petition coming before me on 23-06-2026 for final disposal, in the presence of Sri. P.J.S, Advocate for the Petitioner, Sri. P.S, Advocate for Respondent No.1 and Sri. K.B.S Advocate for Respondent No.2. The matter having stood over for consideration till this day, this Tribunal doth hereby ordered and awarded as follows.

1. The claim petition filed by petitioner under section 166 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 is allowed in part with costs.
2. The minor petitioner is awarded with total compensation of Rs. 1,64,000/-(Rupees One lakh and Sixty-Four Thousand only)with simple interest at the rate of Rs. 6/- percent per annum from the date of petition till its realization.
- 3.Out of the total compensation awarded to minor petitioner, only Rs. 1,00,000/- shall be released in favour of the mother of the minor petitioner and remaining amount with accrued interest shall be deposited as FD for 5 years or till the minor petitioner attain the majority whichever occurs

later in the name of the minor petitioner in any nationalized bank of the choice of his mother and no premature withdrawal of availment of loan is permitted without the prior and specific order by this tribunal.

5. However, the mother of the petitioner is at liberty to withdraw the periodical interest once in 03 months.
6. The respondent No.2-Insurer is liable to pay the compensation to the petitioner and directed to transfer only Rs. 1,00,000/- directly to the bank account of the mother of the minor petitioner and deposit the remaining amount along with interest before this tribunal.
7. The respondent No.2 is directed to pay the compensation with interest first to the minor petitioner and he then recover the same from respondent No.1.
8. The mother of the petitioner is directed to furnish bank accounts details, PAN Card and Adhar Card details along with other particulars which are necessary for transfer of amount.
