

Case called out in the open Court.

Plaintiff is absent.

Defendants are absent.

As per the order passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka in W.P No.17588/2024 clubbed with W.P No.200265/2025 dated 08-07-2025 in a case between Smt. Narayamma V/s The State of Karnataka through its Principle Secretary, all the original suits pending before the Senior Civil Judge Courts having pecuniary jurisdiction upto Rs.15,00,000/- have to be transferred to the Jurisdictional Civil Courts in view of Karnataka Civil Courts (Amendment) Act, 2023 and the Karnataka High Court (Amendment) Act, 2023.

The suit is filed for plaintiff against defendants for declaration of title and permanent injunction and the suit is valued as Rs.6,32,500/-. Therefore, this Court is not having pecuniary jurisdiction to proceed further and try the suit.

Hence, this suit has been transferred to the learned Principle Civil Judge, Kundapura.
