

EXPARTE ORDER ON I.A. NO.II

The plaintiff has filed this suit for permanent injunction. Along with the suit, the plaintiff has also filed I.A. No.II under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 and Section 151 of C.P.C., seeking exparte temporary injunction against defendants.

I have perused the plaint, I.A. No.II, supporting affidavit and documents produced before the Court by the plaintiff. Having been considering the apprehension of the plaintiff, this Court is of the view that it is just and proper to pass exparte order of ad-interim injunction restraining opponents/defendants, their servants, agents or any other persons claiming through them from interfering with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of plaint schedule properties by plucking the usufructs of the agricultural improvements situated in the plaint schedule properties in any manner till next date of hearing. Therefore, this Court proceeds to pass the following:

ORDER

The defendants, their servants, agents or any persons claiming through them are hereby restrained by an exparte order of temporary injunction from interfering with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of plaint schedule properties by plucking the usufructs of the agricultural improvements situated in the plaint schedule properties in any manner till next date of hearing subject to compliance

of the provision of Order XXXIX Rule 3 of C.P.C.

Issue emergent notice of temporary injunction on I.A. No.II to defendants along with suit summons, if process fee paid.
