Order No.13 dated 07.02.2024

Today is fixed for steps upon defendant nos.1, 5, 3, 10 to 12 and 16 to 18 and extension and hearing of the petitions.

Both parties file separate haziras.

Ld. Advocate for defendant nos.2 to 4 verbally move the petitions dated 14.12.2023 and verbally submit the contents of the said petitions and pray for allowing the same to which Ld. Advocate for the plaintiff gives her verbal consent but prays for a cost.

Heard. Considered.

Perused the said two petitions and the case record.

On perusal of the above it is found that defendant nos.2 to 4 have already filed W.S., hence, it can reasonably be assumed that they have an intention to contest the suit. Due to the said reasons the said three petitions are allowed but subject to payment of cost of Rs. 300/- each to be paid by defendant nos.2 to 4 to the plaintiff.

Thus, the suit is taken off from the ex parte board as against defendant nos.2 to 4 and the order for ex parte hearing against defendant nos.2 to 4 is vacated and the W.S. of defendant nos.2 to 4 is accepted but subject to payment of cost of Rs. 300/- each to be paid by defendant nos. 2 to 4 to the plaintiff. No steps is taken by the plaintiff.

The plaintiff by a petition prays for extension of ad interim order of injunction.

Heard. Considered.

The said petition is allowed for the ends of justice.

Let the ad interim order of injunction be extended till the next date.
