JUDGMENT

The accused has been sent up to face trial for the offence punishable under Section 61-1/14 Act by S.H.O. of P.S. City Barnala, in the above noted FIR.

2. Prosecution version in brief is that on 28.11.2017 at about 07:10 PM, in the area of Grain Market, Barnala accused was found in possession of 28 bottles of country made liquor without any valid license or permit.

3. On presentation of the challan, copies of documents relied upon by the prosecution was supplied to the accused, free of costs, as required U/s.207 Cr.P.C.

4. Since a prima-facie case under Section 61-1/14 Act was made out against the accused, charge was framed against the accused, to the contents of which, the accused pleaded guilty and claimed no trial.

5. Accordingly I hold accused guilty under Section 61-1/14 Act and convict him thereunder. Let, he be heard on the quantum of sentence.
