

EXPARTE ORDER ON I.A. NO.II

This Court perused the plaint, I.A. and documents. Heard arguments of learned advocate for plaintiff.

The documents produced depict that the plaintiff has made out prima facie case and balance of convenience lies in favour of the plaintiff. Besides, this Court also of the opinion that the object of granting the injunction would be defeated by delay. Hence, this court pass the following:

ORDER

Issue an ad-interim exparte order of temporary injunction against the defendant, his men, agents or any other persons claiming under him from obstructing, trespassing and interfering with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the suit schedule property till filing objection to I.A.No.II.

The plaintiff shall comply the mandate of order XXXIX Rule 3(a) of CPC.

Issue suit summons, notice on I.A.No.II and injunction order to the defendant.
