**Examination-in-chief by: learned P.P.**

From 06.03.2014 to 02.02.2022, I worked as Senior Scientific Officer, R.F.S.L., Kalaburagi.

On 15.10.2019, the office of the R.F.S.L., Kalaburagi, has received 14 sealed articles from Dy.S.P., Hadagali Sub-division through P.C-756 – Sri.Srishaila (CW.37) in connection with this case. The seals found on the said 14 sealed articles found intact and they tallied with sample seals. Article Nos.1 to 10 and 12 to 14 bear seal SHO. Article No.11 bears seal SK. On the same day, all the said 14 sealed articles were received from reception to biology division of R.F.S.L., Kalaburagi. All said 14 sealed articles were opened on the same day for scientific examination. The descriptions of said 14 sealed articles are as follows: (i) Article No.1 – one Lungi, (ii) Article No.2 – one towel, (iii) Article No.3 – one tetra pack of whisky, (iv) Article No.4 – one tobacco packet, (v) Article No.5 – lime stone powder, (vi) Article No.6 – rupees 10/- note, (vii) Article No.7 – mud, (viii)

Article No.8 – sample mud, (ix) Article No.9 – one T-shirt, (x) Article No.10 – one Burmuda half pant, (xi) Article No.11 – one Macchu, (xii) Article No.12 – one Jerkin, (xiii) Article No.13 – one T-shirt, and (xiv) Article No.14 – one pant. All the above noted article Nos.1 to 14 are marked by the Investigating Officer. The suspected areas were tested for blood using presumptive tests namely Benzidine tests. By conducting Takayama test, the presence of blood stains was confirmed. The origin was determined by cross over Electrophoresis method / Gel diffusion method. The blood grouping was determined by the Absorption Elution method. Serological examination result are as follows: (i) Blood stain was detected in article Nos.1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, 9, 10, 11, 12, and 14, (ii) Blood stain was not detected in article Nos.3, 8, and 13, (iii) Article Nos.1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, 9, 10, 11, 12, and 14 were stained with human blood, and (iv) Article Nos.1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, 9, 10, 11, 12, and 14 were stained with “B” group of blood. I generated the report on 31.10.2019. R.F.S.L. Office, Kalaburagi, has returned article Nos.1 to 14 after putting the R.F.S.L. seal namely “RFSL BS KALABURAGI”, along with the report concerning the said articles and also along with sample seal. Now I see the test report so generated by me which is sent to the Investigating Officer as noted supra. The said test report dated 31.10.2019 is now marked as **Ex.P.72**. My signature therein is now marked as **Ex.P.72(a)**. The said sample seal is now marked as **Ex.P.73** and my signature therein is now marked as **Ex.P.73(a)**. Now I see the acknowledgment dated 15.10.2019 issued by the R.F.S.L., Kalaburagi, regarding receipt of said article Nos.1 to 14 from the Investigating Officer through P.C-756 – Sri.Srisha (CW.37). It bears my signature. The said acknowledgment dated 15.10.2019 is now marked as **Ex.P.74** and my signature therein as **Ex.P.74(a)**. All the article Nos.1 to 14 bear the seal of

biology section of R.F.S.L., Kalaburagi, and my initial signature. Now I see article Nos.1 to 14. They are the ones which were scientifically examined by me as stated by me supra. Now I see them. I also see that article Nos.1 to 14 bear seal of biology section of R.F.S.L., Kalaburagi, and my initial signature. The said article Nos.1 to 14 are already marked as M.O.1 to M.O.10 and M.O.12 to M.O.15. The said seals in M.O.1 to M.O.10 and M.O.12 to M.O.15 are marked as **M.O.1(a), M.O.2(a), M.O.3(a), M.O.4(a), M.O.5(a), M.O.6(a), M.O.7(a), M.O.8(a), M.O.9(a), M.O.10(a), M.O.12(b), M.O.13(a), M.O.14(a), and M.O.15(a)**. My said initial signatures in M.O.1 to M.O.10 and M.O.12 to M.O.15 are marked as **M.O.1(b), M.O.2(b), M.O.3(b), M.O.4(b), M.O.5(b), M.O.6(b), M.O.7(b), M.O.8(b), M.O.9(b), M.O.10(b), M.O.12(c), M.O.13(b), M.O.14(b), and M.O.15(b)**.
