About 5 years back, when myself and C.W.11 had been to Hirehadagali Police Station, Hirehadagali Police have taken our Signatures on some document.

Now Seizure Mahazar dated 01.09.2019 is shown to the Witness and questioned him to identify, whether the said document contains his Signature. Witness answers in the Affirmative. On identification, Seizure Mahazar is marked as Ex.P18 and Signature of the Witness is marked as Ex.P18(a). I do not know the contents of the Seizure Mahazar/Ex.P18; no any materials have been seized by Hirehadagali Police, in our presence.

Now M.O.9- Half Sleeves T-Shirt and M.O.10 – Barmoda present in the Open Court are shown to the Witness and questioned him to identify the same. Witness fails to identify it.

It is false to suggest that, on 01.09.2019 C.W.35 – P.C. 298 produced the Clothes of deceased viz., Half Sleeve T-Shirt and Barmoda before Hirehadagali Police; Hirehadagali Police have seized the said clothes in my presence as well as in the presence of C.W.11, and conducted the Seizure Mahazar, as per Ex.P18; the said Mahazar proceedings were conducted inbetween 06.00 p.m. to 06.45 p.m. in the evening.
