3. Whether the defendant No. 9 proves that, there was partition among the plaintiffs and defendants on 19.06.1995 in respect of the suit B-schedule properties ?
4. Whether the defendant no. 9 proves that, she is absolute owner of the suit schedule item no. 16 of the B-schedule properties by virtue of register sale deed dated 28.10.2004 ?
5. Whether the defendant no. 9 proves that, she is absolute owner of the suit schedule item no. 17 of the B-schedule properties by virtue of register sale deed dated 11.05.2006 ?

6. Whether the defendant no. 13 proves that, he is entitled the his legitimate share over the suit B-schedule properties except Sl. No. 13 and 14 in item no. 1 of the suit B-schedule properties ?
7. Whether the defendant no. 13 proves that, Sl. No. 13 and 14 in item no. 1 of the suit B-schedule properties are the self acquired properties of the Hanumakka W/o Hanumanthappa who is the mother of the defendant no. 13 ?
8. What order or decree?
