CLAIM:-

The Petition filed U/Sec. 166 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1989.

Therefore, it is prayed that the Hon'ble Court may be pleased to award global compensation of Rs. 10,00,000/- along with interest at Rs. 12% per annum from the date of the accident till the realization in favour of the petitioner as against the respondents No. 1 to 3 and grant such other relief and costs as deem fit in the circumstances of the case.

That on 11.04.2016 at about 5.15 P.M. in the evening the minor petitioner along with Mahesh were riding bicycle on Chikkajogihalli road near Swamy Vivekananda School near land of Yajamanappa on the left side of the road at relevant time the Respondent No. 1 came from M.B. Ayyanahalli side by droving the Maxi Truck bearing Reg. No. KA-35/B-4904. In a high speed with rash and negligent manner and dashed to the minor petitioner's back side bicycle. As a result of which minor petitioner sustained injuries i.e., a fresh irregular open wound over the right partial region measuring 3 cm length, 1 cm depth, 1 cm width, a fresh abraded wound over the shoulder right wound aspect and fresh bleeding from nose and other bleeding injuries on all over the body.

With the Jurisdiction of Khanahosahalli Police Station, Respondent No. 1 is a Driver of the Maxi Truck, Respondent No. 2 is a Owner of the Maxi Truck and Respondent No. 3 is a Insurer.

AWARD:-

This Petition coming on this day for final disposal before me, in presence of Sri. S. Mallikarjuna, Advocate for the Petitioner, Sri. C. Virupakshappa, Advocate for Respondent No. 1 and 2, Sri. Jina Chandrakumar Gogi, Advocate for Respondent No. 3 and Judgment pronounced this day as under:

It is ordered and awarded that, Claim petition is hereby allowed in part with costs.

It is further ordered and awarded that, Claimant is entitled to total compensation of Rs. 1,88,790/- (Rupees One lakh, Eighty-eight thousand, Seven hundred and Ninety only) with costs and future interest at the rate of 6% p.a. from the date of the petition till realization.

It is further ordered and awarded that, The respondent No. 2 and 3 are held jointly and severally liable to pay the aforesaid compensation amount to the claimant.

It is further ordered and awarded that, The respondent No. 3 being the insurer is directed to deposit the entire compensation amount with interest before this Tribunal within one month from the date of this order.

It is further ordered and awarded that, After depositing the compensation, claimant is permitted to withdraw 60% of the compensation and the balance 40% be invested in F.D's in the name of minor petitioner for a period of 5 years in any nationalized Banks.

It is further ordered and awarded that, Advocate's fee is fixed at Rs. 1,000/-.
