**ISSUES**

1. Whether the plaintiff proves that the correctness of the genealogical tree?
2. Whether the plaintiff proves that the suit schedule properties are ancestral joint family properties available for partition?
3. Whether the plaintiff further proves that at the time of propositus Bheemappa, he utilised the ancestral property as the capital for the his business?
4. Whether there are self acquired properties other than the suit schedule properties as narrated in the plaint which are left out of the purview of the suit?

5. Whether the suit suffers from mis-joinder of necessary parties and properties?
6. Whether the plaintiff proves that the joint family nucleus remained in-tact in spite of their declaration given the income tax authorities as alleged in the suit?
7. If so, the said statement given to the authorities by the plaintiff is false and incorrect?
8. Whether defendant No. 3 proves that the suit schedule item No. 6 to 9 and item No. 11 to 13 are his self acquired properties?
9. Whether the plaintiff is entitled for the relief sought for?
10. What Order or Decree?
