SUIT FOR DECLARATION

Suit Claim :

The plaintiff No. 1 and 2 are prays that, the Hon'ble Court may be pleased to pass an order by granting the following reliefs:-

- a) To declare that the plaintiff No. 1 is the legally wedded wife and the plaintiff No. 2 is the daughter of plaintiff No. 1 and deceased P. Thilukappa and they are the Class-I legal heirs to the deceased P. Tilukappa son of late Ningappa who died on 07.03.2019.
- b) To direct the 2nd defendant, The plaintiff No. 1 and 2 are entitled to receive the amount deposited and invested by the deceased P. Tilukappa son of late Ningappa purchasing the VCC (Vijayanagara Case Certificate) Bond bearing No. 25986 for Rs. 9,00,000-00 (Rupees Nine lakh only) from the second Defendant Bank.
- c) To direct the second Defendant Bank to pay the deposited amount of Rs. 9,00,000-00 (Rupees Nine lakh only) along with upto date interest from 17.09.2018 deposited by the deceased P. Tilukappa son of late Ningappa in favour of the plaintiff. The 1st defendant will

not entitle to claim the VCC bond amount deposited by the deceased P. Tilukappa even though her name entered in the VCC Bond, when the plaintiff No. 1 and 2 are the class I heirs and they are entitled to claim the deposited amount under law.

d) To pass such other order or orders, as this Hon'ble Court deems fit and proper under the circumstances of the case.

And further, it is ordered and decreed that, the defendant No. 2 is hereby directed to release the VCC Bond Ex.D-1 maturity amount in favour of plaintiffs No. 1 and 2.

And further, it is also ordered and decreed that, the defendant No. 1 is hereby directed to handover the F.D. bond to the plaintiffs immediately.
