**COMMITTAL ORDER UNDER SECTION 232 of
BNSS**

The Police Sub-Inspector of Haluvagalu Police Station, Harapanahalli Taluk, Vijayanagara District has filed charge sheet against the above named accused No.1 to 7 are alleging that they are committed the offences punishable under Section. 189(2), 191(2), 329(4), 352, 118(1), 115(2), 74, 76, 133, 351(2) R/w Section 190 of BNS.

2. On receiving the prosecution papers they were perused and cognizance for the offences punishable Section 189(2), 191(2), 329(4), 352, 118(1), 115(2), 74, 76, 133, 351(2) R/w Section 190 of BNS was taken. On production of the accused No.1 to 7 prosecution papers were furnished to the accused persons as contemplated U/s.230 of BNSS.

3. As per the orders passed in CrI. M.P No.5588/2025 by the Hon'ble Addl District and Session Judge, Vijayanagara district Hosapete dated 18.10.2025 the accused persons are released on bail.

4. On perusing the prosecution papers offences alleged against the accused No.1 to 7

punishable under Section 76 of BNS. The offence punishable under Section 76 of BNS is having maximum punishment of imprisonment which shall not be less than three years but which may extend to seven years and shall also be liable to fine. The above said offences are exclusively triable by the Honble Court of Sessions. Hence this court is of the view that the case is to be committed to the Hon'ble Court of Sessions for trial. Heard both sides on committal.

5. The accused No.1 to 7 hereby directed to appear before the Hon'ble Principal District and Session Judge, Hosapete for trial as and when directed to do on all dates of hearing for trial. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDERS

Acting U/Sec. 232 of BNSS this case is committed to the Hon'ble Principal District and Session Judge, Hosapete

1. Copies of the prosecution papers furnished to the accused No.1 to 7.
2. Submit the entire records of the case and the documents and articles, if

any, which are to be produced in evidence to the Hon'ble Principal District and Session Judge, Hospete

3. Notify the Public Prosecutor about committal of the case to the Hon'ble Principal District and Session Judge, Hospete
4. Since the accused No.1 to 7 on bail and they are directed to appear before the Hon'ble Principal District and Session Judge, Hospete whenever they receive the summons, from the court.
5. Surety is directed to keep present the accused No.1 to 7 on all dates of hearing whenever called upon.
