- 1. Whether the plaintiff proves that herself and defendants are undivided joint family members ?**
- 2. Whether the plaintiff proves that suit schedule properties are ancestral and undivided joint family properties of herself and defendants and they are in joint possession of said properties ?**
- 3. Whether the defendant Nos.2 and 3 prove that suit schedule property were fallen to the share of Gowramma in the registered partition deed dated:29-08-1977 as contended in their written statement ?**
- 4. Whether the defendant Nos.2 and 3 prove that said Gowramma has executed un-registered relinquishment deed in favour of defendant No.2 with respect to the suit schedule properties as contended in their written statement ?**
- 5. Whether the defendant No.1 proves that Gowramma has bequeathed suit schedule properties by executing un registered WILL dated: 27-08-1998 in her favour and she has valid right, title, interest and possession over the suit schedule properties by virtue of said WILL as contended in her written statement ?**
- 6. Whether the defendants prove that the suit is barred by law of limitation ?**
- 7. Whether the defendants prove that the suit is bad for non- joinder of necessary parties ?**

- 8. Whether the defendants prove that this court has no pecuniary jurisdiction to try the suit ?**
- 9. Whether the plaintiff is entitled for partition ? If so, to what extent ?**
- 10. What order or decree ?**
