Examination-in-Chief by Ld. Spl. P.P.:

I am Serving as the Medical Officer, in THC, Basavana Bagewadi since, 21.07.2018 to 31.01.2024.

On 07.05.2023, a patient by name Sharanbasu Hanumantaray Walikar has appeared before me at Taluka Government Hospital, Basavana Bagewadi with an history of assault conducted on 07.05.2023 at about 7.30pm; he was brought to the hospital at 9.00pm. I have medically examined the said patient and found 1) lacerated wound measuring 5 ½ cms X 1 ½ cms X Bone deep over the left fronto temporal region; lacerated wound over the left leg towards anterior aspects, measuring 1cm X 1cm X 1 ½ cm. I have given first Aid treatment to the said patient and sent the said patient to District

Government Hospital, Vijayapura for further management; for which the patient was admitted in the Government Hospital Vijayapura on 07.05.2023 and discharged on 15.05.2023, as an inpatient No.12704, wherein the patient was diagnosed as a soft tissue injury.

As per me, the above said two injuries are Simple in nature, could be caused by blunt object; and they were fresh in nature, at the time of my medical examination.

I have issued wound Certificate to this effect, on going through the Medical documents pertaining to the patient issued by the District Government Hospital, Vijayapura. Now I see the said Wound Certificate. On identification the Wound Certificate is marked as Ex.P17 and Signature of the Witness is marked as Ex.P17(a).

On 24.08.2023, Taluka Government Hospital, Basavana Bagewadi has received a Requisition from DySP., Basavana Bagewadi/C.W.19, alongwith three objects in a sealed cover, with a request to issue Weapon Opinion inconnection with the injuries found in the Wound Certificate/Ex.P.17.

On the same day, I have unsealed the said three objects and found Digging Axe (Pick Axe), Wooden handle Digging Axe measuring 10 inches in length, having 3 inches at the blade and 1 inch at the base, with thickness of 2 cms; and Wooden handle measuring 23 inches in length, and 4 inches of circumference.

The second and third articles are two pieces of Wooden Stick, measuring 23 inches in length, 5 inches in circumference; and 24 inches in length, 6 inches in circumference.

I have inspected the said articles and on examination, I am of the opine that, the injuries shown in the Wound Certificate/Ex.P.17

could be caused with blunt end of article No.1; and from both the ends of articles No.2 and 3.

After examination, I have packed, labled, sealed and affixed my signature on it; and sent it back to DySP., Basavana Bagewadi Police Sub-Division, alongwith my Opinion.

On identification, the said Opinion is marked as Ex.P.18, signature of the witness is marked as Ex.P.18(a).

Now, M.O.1 and M.O.2 present in the Open Court are shown to the Witness and questioned him to identify them. Witness identifies them.

Cross-Examination by: Smt. DRB Adv., for Accused Nos.1 to 4:

I have not issued any MLC Report to the Jurisdictional Police Station on receipt of the patient.

I do not know as to who had accompanied with the patient to Taluka Hospital, Basavana Bagewadi, seeking medical examination.

Neither I have enquired the patient, as to who has assaulted him, nor the patient has informed me the name of the assailants.

It is true to suggest that, injuries shown in the Wound Certificate/Ex.P.17 could be caused to a person, if such person falls from a running Motorcycle.

It is false to suggest that, I am deposing falsely that, I have issued false Certificate as per Ex.P.17 and Weapon Opinion as per Ex.P.18, at the instance of Basavana Bagewadi Police.
