

ORDER

The plaintiff has filed the suit for partition and separate possession of her $\frac{1}{2}$ share in respect of suit schedule properties.

2. Along with the plaint, IA No.1 is filed by the plaintiff U/Sec.80(2) CPC praying for dispensation of issuance of prior notice to defendant No-9 to 11 who are the statutory authorities.

3. In the affidavit annexed to IA No.1 it is averred that, the matter is very urgent and if prior notice is issued to defendant No-9 to 11 then, irreparable loss and hardship will be caused to the plaintiff. On perusal of the records and considering the urgency in the matter, prior issuance of notice to defendant No.9 to 11 U/Sec.80 (2) CPC is hereby dispensed with.

4. The plaintiff has also filed IA No-II U/o 39, Rule 1 & 2 R/W 151 of CPC seeking an order of temporary injunction against the defendant No-3 & 4 from alienating the suit schedule properties. In support of it, the plaintiff has filed her affidavit. The plaintiff has also filed record of rights and copies of mutation entries pertains to the suit properties.

5. At this juncture it is proper to pass any orders on IA No-II only after hearing the defendants.

6. Hence issue emergent notice on IA No-II to defendant No.3 and 4 and suit summons to all defendants.
