1. *Whether the plaintiff proves that, the plaintiff and defendants No.1 to 6 constitute Hindu joint family and they are in joint possession of the suit property?*
2. *Whether the plaintiff further proves that, the suit schedule property is joint family property of plaintiff and defendant No.1 to 6?*
3. *Whether the plaintiff further proves that, she has got partition and separate possession of her 1/3rd share in the 1/4th share of defendant No.1 and also 1/3rd share in the compensation amount in respect of the suit schedule property?*
4. *Whether the defendant No.1 proves that, the suit of the plaintiff is bad for non-jonder of necessary parties and also bad for non-inclusion of all the joint family properties?*
5. *Whether the defendant No.1 further proves that, the defendant No.1 and 4 to 6 became absolute owner of the suit property by virtue of relinquishment as stated in para 4 of the written statement?*
6. *What the relief parties are entitled for?*
7. *What order or decree?*
