**Petition for Mutual
Consent Divorce u/s. 28 of
The Special Marriage Act,
1954**

Petitioners most respectfully submits as follows:-

- 1) That, the said marriage of Petitioner No. 1 and Petitioner No. 2 was a arranged marriage performed on **18/01/2013** as per the Hindu rituals and rites at Valli Annamalai, Tirumana Mahal, Gingee, Villupuram, Tamilnadu bearing Marriage Certificate No. 636/2016 dt. 16/04/2016 **(Certificate of Marriage is filed on record for kind perusal of this Hon'ble Court).**
- 2) That after the marriage Petitioner No. 2 stayed at & Petitioner No. 1's house till 25/01/2023 and thereafter due to internal clashes and understanding between both of them they could not carry on their marital relations in a healthy way and thereafter the Petitioner No. 2 is staying alongwith her parents at the address stated hereinabove and the separation period is above 1 year till today so the clause of separation period for dissolution of marriage by mutual consent is fulfilled by the Petitioner No. 1 & 2.
- 3) That, in the said holy wedlock Petitioner No. 2 delivered a female daughter named Litika Prabhu Naidu on 17/11/2013, a female daughter Priyal Prabhu Naidu on 01/04/2018 & a male son named Aaryan Prabhu Naidu on 21/04/2022 **(verified copies of birth certificates & Aadhar Cards is filed on record for kind perusal of this Hon'ble Court)** who all at present are staying alongwith Petitioner No.1 for which Petitioner No.2 has no objection from her side.

- 4) That, the Petitioners submit that during the past, they have realized that their likings, tastes of life, temperaments, ideas, ideologies, thinking, attitudes, aptitudes, intellectual reactions, capacities, feelings, moods, habits, nature and life are so different from each other that it would not be possible for them to live together in future. There is no hope for both the Petitioners living together peacefully henceforth.
- 5) That, the Petitioners, their relatives and friends have tried their best to have reconciliation for a happy domesticity, but they have been very unfortunate to bring about the same. Thus, the marriage of Petitioner No. 1 and 2 is broken down irretrievably and there is absolutely no possibility of their reunion.
- 6) That, the Petitioners also submit and declare that they have been residing separately from last more than 1 Year i.e. since **25/01/2023** hence, this petition is maintainable. The Petitioner No. 1 and Petitioner No. 2 are residing separately at their given addresses since 25/01/2023.
- 7) That, the Petitioners have therefore, decided to dissolve their marriage by mutual consent on following terms and conditions and hence this petition.
- 8) That, it is agreed by Petitioner No. 2 that she has released, waived her right of maintenance permanently and in future also Petitioner No. 2 will not file any suit, case for claiming any kind of

maintenance from Petitioner No.1 for herself and it has also been agreed that she will not demand custody of child nor any rights in the property of Petitioner No.1 or his relatives nor in ancestral property.

- 9) That it has been mutually agreed between Petitioner No.1 & 2 that if at all Petitioner No.2 desires to meet the child in future then it shall be solely as per Petitioner No.1's will, consent and prior permission.
- 10) That, both the Petitioners have agreed not to claim any right, title and interest in each other's movable as well as immovable properties in future.
- 11) That, there is no any case, dispute filed or pending before any court against each other. And it is agreed between Petitioner No. 1 and Petitioner No. 2 that in future also they will not file any kind of suits, cases against each other regarding matrimonial relations.
- 12) That, both the Petitioners have agreed not to interfere with the lives of each other henceforth.
- 13) That, the Petitioners do hereby declare and confirm that the decision of divorce by mutual consent taken by them is upon their own volition. There is no fraud, coercion or undue influence acting upon them while arriving at the said decision and this petition preferred by them is not collusive.
- 14) That the requisite Court fees has been affixed to the present petition as per the provisions of law.

- 15) That, the Petitioners submit that they have lastly resided together within the local limits of the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble court, and hence, this Hon'ble court has got jurisdiction to try, entertain and decide the present petition.
- 16) This Marriage Petition No.32/2025 for divorce u/s 28 of Special Marriage Act, 1954 is decided before Shri. P. R. Chaudhary District Judge-16 and Addl. Sessions Judge, Pune in presence of Advocate for Petitioner :- Adv. Shri. Raju Madhavan.
Following order is passed..

ORDER

i] The application for mutual divorce u/s 28 of Spl. Marriage Act is allowed.

ii] The relation between the applicant no. 1 Prabhu Laxman Naidu and party no. 2 Aishwarya @ Iswariya Prabhu Naidu as wife and husband comes to an end from the date of this order.
