Further, he filed another I.A. under Order 32 Rule 3 of CPC for appointment of minor guardian of defendant No.6 his natural mother defendant No.4.

Counsel for defendants submitted no objections to interim applications.

Heard and IAs are allowed.

The plaintiffs shall amend the plaint and filed the amended plaint. The documents are taken on record.

The defendant No.4 is appointed as minor guardian of defendant No.6 who is natural mother.

Both parties and their counsels present. They submitted that there is a chance of settlement. The counsel for defendant No.6 who is minor guardian filed IA under Order 32 Rule 7 along with certificate for permission to enter into compromise on behalf of the minor defendant No.6 by his natural mother defendant No.4. Both counsel submitted that in the proposed compromise certain properties are allotted to the share of minor defendant No.6 and the proposed compromise is in the best interest of minor defendant No.6. Accordingly, the counsel for defendant No.6 has filed IA for seeking permission and also certificate stating that the proposed compromise is in the best interest of minor defendant No.6.

Heard and perused the records.

The proposed compromise is in the best interest of minor defendant No.6. Hence, I.A. filed by the counsel for

defendant No.6 under Order 32 Rule 7 of CPC is hereby allowed. The defendant No.4 is being the natural mother of minor defendant N.6 is permitted to enter into compromise on behalf of minor defendant No.6.

Plaintiffs No.1 to 3, defendants No.1 to 5 and their respective counsel are present. Negotiation is held, both parties have agreed to compromise the matter. Accordingly, they filed application under Order 23 Rule 3 of CPC along with their ID proof.

As per the terms of joint compromise petition in all 26 plots are allotted to the share of plaintiff No.1, in all 25 plots are allotted to the share of plaintiff No.2, in all 26 plots are allotted to the share of defendant No.2, in all 10 plots are allotted to the share of defendant No.3, the plot in Sy.No.628/2/16 and

Sy.No.723/B/14 two plots are allotted to the share of defendant No.5.

In all 10 plots are allotted to the share of defendant No.6.

The plot No.23 situated at Ahirsang village is jointly allotted to the share of plaintiff No.1, 2 and defendant No.2.

The land in Sy.No.586/2A/2 measuring 1 acre 26 guntas is allotted to the share of defendant No.1. Further, in all 79 plots are allotted to the share of defendant No.1. Further, the land in Sy.No.628/A3/11 measuring one Gunta one Ana in Sy.No.650/21 measuring 2 guntas, in Sy.No.650/11/2 measuring 1 acre, in Sy.No.723/3 measuring 20 guntas are allotted to the share of defendant No.1.

The plaintiff No.3 and defendant No.4 are having no share in the suit properties, as the shares are allotted to their children. Therefore, they vountarily relinquished their right in favour of their children. The terms of joint compromise petition is read over to both parties in the language known to them. They voluntarily agreed upon the same. The

terms of joint compromise is lawful. The parties have already taken their possession of their respective shares. In view of the same, we proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

The joint compromise petition filed by the plaintiffs and defendants under Order 23 Rule 3 of CPC is hereby allowed.

The suit of the plaintiffs is decreed in terms of joint compromise petition.

The joint compromise petition shall be the part of the decree.

Both parties are directed to furnish the requisite stamp for drawing final decree.

Draw final decree accordingly.
