It is seen that accused Abhishek Kumar was without arrest during investigation and was bound down by the IO as he cooperated in the present case.

In terms of Hon'ble Supreme Court judgement in **S.K. Antil Vs. CBI**, accused Abhishek Kumar is admitted to bail on furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- with one surety in the like amount.

Accused Abhishek Kumar seeks an opportunity to file fresh surety as he cannot arrange the same today.

Heard. Allowed.

Accused Abhishek Kumar is bound down for NDOH on personal bond furnished by him.

Put up for furnishing bail bonds of accused Abhishek Kumar for NDOH.

On the basis of material available on record, prima facie case for the offence punishable under Section 279/304-A IPC and 146/196 & 39/192 M.V. Act is made out against the accused Akash Kumar and offence punishable under Section 146/196 & 39/192 M.V. Act is made out against the accused Abhishek Kumar. Accordingly, notice framed against both the accused separately to which they have pleaded not guilty and claimed trial.
