J U D G M E N T(Dated 12th June, 2023)

Accused No.01 and 02 have voluntarily pleaded guilty. Hence, they are held guilty for the offence punishable under Section 12(a) of the Bombay Prevention of Gambling Act, 1887. The punishment provided for such offence is both with fine which may extend to Rs.300/- and with imprisonment which may extend to 03 months. I have heard both the accused on the point of sentence. They prayed for leniency. They submitted that they are poor persons. I am satisfied that, both the accused have pleaded guilty voluntarily. Hence, considering the nature of offence and punishment provided, the following order will meet the ends of justice. Therefore, I pass the following order :-

O R D E R

1.	Accused No.01 Agnidev Shivraj Honrao , R/o. Jamb, At.P. Bhagya Nagar, Ahmedpur Tq. Ahmedpur Dist. Latur and accused No.02. Laxmikant Arjun Bansode are convicted vide 252 of Code of Criminal Procedure for the offence punishable under Section 12(a) of the Bombay Prevention of Gambling Act and sentenced to suffer imprisonment till the rising of the Court and to pay fine of Rs.300/- each (Rupees Three hundred only) in default to suffer simple imprisonment for the period 02 days.
2.	The amount of Rs.1,420/- (Rupees One thousand four hundred twenty only) in the offence be forfeited to the Government.
3.	The seized peace of paper being worthless be destroyed after appeal period is over.
4.	The seized mobile phone of Realme be sold after appeal period by auction sale and proceed be credited to government as per rules.
5.	Copy of this judgment be given to both the accused free of cost. [Pronounced in open Court.]
