

IN THE NATIONAL LOK-ADALAT

ORDER BELOW EXH. 1

This case is based on the police report filed under Section 210(1)(b), r/w. Section 2(h) of the Bharaitya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (in short 'the BNSS'). In the report the alleged offence provides a sentence of fine only. In view of Section 514(1) and 514(2)(a) of the BNSS, a limitation for taking cognizance of the alleged offence is six months only. On careful scrutiny of the record in the proceeding it clearly reveals that the report has been filed beyond the period of six months from the date of commission of alleged offence. In view of the bar put in the abovesaid provision of the BNSS for taking cognizance of the offence in this matter, a cognizance cannot be taken by this Court and accordingly, this case is required to be disposed off in view of Section 514(1) of the BNSS. Hence, the case stands disposed of.
