

Order under Exhibit - 1

The accused have been booked under certain penal provisions of IPC, which are compoundable by the owner of the property stolen as per Section 320(1) of CrPC. The de facto complainant, who has appeared before this Court through virtual mode, has expressed its wish to compound the offence. In view of the wish expressed by the de facto complainant, the accused shall stand acquitted as per Section 320 (8) of the CrPC. A yadi be sent to the jailor directing him to release the accused in custody, if any, in the present case.

Furthermore, the SHO of the concerned police station is ordered that whenever a better claimant approaches the police station seeking custody of stolen property and if the same is recovered and available with the police station, then, it shall handed over to the claimant after verifying credentials *qua* identity and ownership of the claimant.
