Brief facts of the case are that on the complaint of the complainant, case FIR No. 157/2025 dated 02.08.2025 under Sections 303(2) of BNS was registered in P.S. Balh, District Mandi, H.P. Police conducted investigation and ultimately filed untraced report.

Notice of untrace report was sent to the complainant/informant who appeared before this today and deposed on oath that he is satisfied with the investigation of police and he has no clue about the culprits. Further, he has no objection if the present untrace report is accepted.

Heard. I have also perused the entire record carefully. After taking into consideration, facts and circumstances of the case in its entirety, I find no reason to disagree with the untrace report filed by the police. Moreover, no prejudice would be caused to the complainant, if the present untrace report is accepted as the police and complainant can get the present FIR revived as and when culprit is apprehended or any information regarding the culprit comes to their knowledge/notice. Accordingly, the untrace Report filed by the police is accepted and Case FIR No. 157/2025 dated 02.08.2025 under Sections 303(2) of BNS is ordered to be kept as untraced. Criminal Ahlmad is directed to do the needful and to comply all the directions passed by Hon'ble High Court of H.P. with regard to untrace/cancellation report.
