

O.S.No.69/2025

The plaintiff has filed this application seeking an ad-interim ex-parte temporary injunction order against defendant No.2, 23, 24, 25 restraining them from alienating, or transferring suit schedule properties bearing R.S.No.4/3/A+B measuring 3 acres, R.S.No.4/4 measuring 1 acre 1 gunta, R.S.No.4/5 measuring 2 acres 38 guntas, R.S.No.6/1 measuring 3 acres 14 guntas, R.S.No.6/3 measuring 2 acres 35 guntas and VPC No.77/1, VPC No.77/2 and VPC No.526 which are situated at Tilagol village till disposal of suit.

On perusal of plaint averments, affidavit and documents produced by plaintiff, it goes to show that, there appears prima-facie case in favour of plaintiff and plaintiff has made out sufficient grounds to grant an ex-parte temporary injunction order. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

Defendant No.2, 23, 24, 25 are hereby restrained by an order of ad-interim ex-parte temporary injunction order from alienating, or transferring suit schedule properties bearing R.S.No.4/3/A+B measuring 3 acres, R.S.No.4/4 measuring 1 acre 1 gunta, R.S.No.4/5 measuring 2 acres 38 guntas, R.S.No.6/1 measuring 3 acres 14 guntas, R.S.No.6/3 measuring 2 acres 35 guntas and VPC No.77/1, VPC No.77/2 and VPC No.526 which are situated at Tilagol village till next date of hearing.

The plaintiff shall comply the proviso U/o. 39 Rule 3(a) and 3(b) of CPC.

Issue ex-parte temporary injunction notice on I.A.No.1 to defendant No.2, 23, 24, 25 and suit summons to defendants, if P.F paid and copies furnished.
