

O.S.No.213/2025

The plaintiffs have filed this application seeking an ad-interim ex-parte temporary injunction order against defendants restraining them from alienating, transferring or mortgaging or encumbering suit schedule properties bearing R.S.No.69/5 measuring 2 acres 5 guntas, situated at Kurubathalli village, Almel taluka and VPC.No.61/2B situated at Kurubathalli village till disposal of suit.

On perusal of plaint averments, affidavit and documents produced by plaintiffs, it goes to show that, there appears prima-facie case in favour of plaintiffs and plaintiffs have made out sufficient grounds to grant an ex-parte temporary injunction order. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

Defendants are hereby restrained by an order of ad-interim ex-parte

temporary injunction order from alienating, transferring or mortgaging or encumbering suit schedule properties bearing R.S.No.69/5 measuring 2 acres 5 guntas, situated at Kurubathalli village, Almel taluka and VPC.No.61/2B situated at Kurubathalli village till next date of hearing.

The plaintiffs shall comply the proviso U/o.39 Rule 3(a) and 3(b) of CPC.

Issue ex-parte temporary injunction notice on I.A.No.1 and suit summons to defendants, if P.F paid and copies furnished.
