

O.S.No.157/2025

The plaintiffs have filed this application seeking an ad-interim ex-parte temporary injunction order against defendants restraining defendant No.1 and 6 from alienating suit schedule properties bearing R.S.No. 12 measuring 5 acres 31 guntas situated at Honnahalli village, Sindagi taluka dist: Vijayapur either by way of sale, gift, mortgage, charge etc., or in any other manner pending disposal of suit.

On perusal of plaint averments, affidavit and documents produced by plaintiffs, it goes to show that, there appears prima-facie case in favour of plaintiffs and plaintiffs have made out sufficient grounds to grant an ex-parte temporary injunction order. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

Defendant No.1 and 6 are hereby restrained by an order of ad-interim ex-parte temporary injunction order from alienating suit schedule properties bearing R.S.No. 12 measuring 5 acres 31 guntas situated at Honnahalli village, Sindagi taluka dist: Vijayapur either by way of sale, gift, mortgage, charge etc., or in any other manner till next date of hearing.

The plaintiffs shall comply the proviso U/o. 39 Rule 3(a) and 3(b) of CPC.

Issue ex-parte temporary injunction notice on I.A.No.I to defendant No.1 and 6, I.A.No.III to defendant No.3 and suit summons to defendants, if P.F paid and copies furnished.
