The plaintiff has filed I.A.No.I seeking an ad-interim ex-parte temporary injunction order against defendant restraining her from alienating or changing the revenue records pertaining to suit schedule property bearing R.S.No.357/1 measuring 5 acres 14 guntas, R.S.No.357/3 measuring 5 acres and R.S.No.357/4 measuring 5 acres, all are situated at Handiganur village, Devara-Hippargi taluka and house property situated at Ward No.18 bearing TMC No.1663 and house property situated at Ward No.20 bearing TMC No.1685/A of Sindagi town till disposal of suit.

On perusal of plaint averments, affidavit and documents produced by plaintiff, it goes to show that, there appears prima-facie case in favour of plaintiff and plaintiff has made out sufficient grounds to grant an ex-parte

temporary injunction order. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

Defendant is hereby restrained by an order of ad-interim ex-parte temporary injunction order from alienating or changing the revenue records pertaining to suit schedule property bearing R.S.No.357/1 measuring 5 acres 14 guntas, R.S.No.357/3 measuring 5 acres and R.S.No.357/4 measuring 5 acres, all are situated at Handiganur village, Devara-Hippargi taluka and house property situated at Ward No.18 bearing TMC No.1663 and house property situated at Ward No.20 bearing TMC No.1685/A of Sindagi town till next date of hearing.

The plaintiff shall comply the proviso U/o.39 Rule 3(a) and 3(b) of CPC.

Issue ex-parte temporary injunction notice on I.A.No.I and suit

summons to defendant, if P.F paid and
copies furnished.
