

O.S.No.279/2025

The plaintiff has filed I.A.No.II seeking an ad-interim ex-parte temporary injunction order against defendants restraining them from alienating, transferring, mortgaging or creating any third party right by any means or modes over suit schedule properties till disposal of suit.

On perusal of plaint averments, affidavit and documents produced by plaintiff, it goes to show that, there appears prima-facie case in favour of plaintiff and plaintiff has made out sufficient grounds to grant an ex-parte temporary injunction order. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

Defendants are hereby restrained by an order of ad-interim ex-parte temporary injunction order from alienating, transferring, mortgaging or creating any third party right by any

means or modes over suit schedule properties till next date of hearing.

The plaintiff shall comply the proviso U/o.39 Rule 3(a) and 3(b) of CPC.

Issue ex-parte temporary injunction notice on I.A.No.II to defendants and suit summons to defendants, if P.F paid and copies furnished.
