ORDER ON COMPROMISE PETITION

As the plaintiff and defendant No.1, 2, 3A to 3D, 4A to 4B, 5, 7, 9A, 9B, 10, 11, 14 to 21, 23 and 24 are present with their respective counsel and filed a Compromise Petition U/O.XXIII Rule 3 of C.P.C. and submitted that they have settled matter among themselves, as the plaintiff has received from Rs.12 Lakhs from the defendant No.3A to D3 and defendant No.4 as mentioned in the compromise petition, there was already partition with respect to the suit properties in the year 1973 and 2000, the plaintiff and defendants all agreed not to challenge the partition taken among themselves. All the contents at para No.2A to 2E, read over to them on 25.4.2026 itself, they agreed for the same. Further counsel for plaintiff filed a memo against the defendant No.6, 12 and 13 stating that, they are not having any claim against them, hence prays to permit to withdraw the suit against them. Same is permitted.
