Respondents No. 1(a), 19, 2(d), 1(h), 29, 2(b), 1(b) and 1(d) are duly served through the Speed Post at Exh. 44-45, 98-99, 66-67, 56-57, 118-119, 62-63, 46-47 and 50-51. They failed to appear after service. Hence, appeal be heard ex-parte against him in view of 41 Rule 17 (2) of C.P.C.
