ORDER ON I A. No.I

Heard the learned counsel for the plaintiff, perused the plaint averments and other relevant documents. This suit is filed by the plaintiff for the relief of partition and Separate possession against the against the defendants No.1 and 2.

The plaintiff has filed Interlocutory Application U/O. XXXIX Rules 1 and 2 R/w. Section 151 of CPC seeking Ex-party temporary injunction restraining the defendants from alienation of the suit properties till disposal of the suit.

On perusal of the plaint, documents produced by the plaintiff and affidavit filed in support of the application, it is contended that, It is contended that plaintiff and defendant No.1 and 2 as it is contended that sale deed executed in favour of the plaintiff as per order of the Hon'ble Senior Civil Court in Ex.P No.41/2023 dated 13/12/2024 through court Commissioner but now the defendants are causing interference with possession of the suit property hence present suit is filed along with this application.

At this stage, the plaintiff has made out prima-facie case for grant of Ex-parte temporary injunction. If the notice is not dispensed at this stage, which leads to multiplicity of proceedings. Therefore, the notice at this stage is dispensed. Accordingly, this Court proceeds to pass the following:

ORDER

By an order of Ex-party temporary injunction the defendants from interference over suit property , till next date of hearing.

Issue Temporary injunction order, notice on I.A.No.I along with suit summons to the defendants, if the plaintiff comply with the provisions of Order 39 Rule 3 (a) of CPC.
