ORDER

The petitioner has filed this petition U/Sec. 13(3) of the Registration of Births and Deaths Act, 1969 seeking to direct the respondent to enter his date of birth as 16.01.2008 in the concerned register and to issue the birth certificate.

2. The brief facts of the petitioner's case are that:

That, the petitioner was born on 16.01.2008 at Nasalwai village, Tq: Gurumitkal, Dist: Yadgiri. However, through

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oversight, the event of the birth of the petitioner was not communicated to the office of Respondent. Thereafter, the petitioner being in need of his birth certificate for availing government benefits and other purposes made an application to the respondent's office seeking to issue his birth certificate. But the respondent, after verification of records, has issued non-availability certificate stating that the date of birth of the petitioner is not found in the concerned register maintained in his office. Hence, the petition.

3. After registration of the petition, notice was issued to the respondent. However, none appeared despite service of notice on the respondent. Hence, the respondent has been noted absent.

4. Thereafter, the petitioner got examined as PW.1 and produced 3 documents marked as Ex.P-1 to 3.

5. Heard arguments of learned counsel for the petitioner.

6. The points that would arise for my consideration are as follows:-

1. Whether the petition deserves to be allowed?



2. What order?

7. This Court proceeds to answer the above points as under:

8. POINT NO. 1: The petitioner, in support of his case, has produced Ex.P-1 non-availability certificate issued by the office of respondent, Ex.P-2 Notarized copy of SSLC marks card and Ex.P-3 Notarized copy of his father's Aadhar card.

9. On perusal of Ex.P-1 non-availability certificate issued by the respondent it can be seen that the date of birth of the petitioner has not been entered in the concerned register maintained in the respondent's office. In the petition as well as in the chief-examination affidavit of the Pw.1, it is stated that the petitioner was born on 16.01.2008. Even Ex.P-2 SSLC marks card shows that the petitioner was born on 16.01.2008.

10. This Court has no reasons to disbelieve the evidence produced by the petitioner. It is stated that, the birth certificate

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of the petitioner is required for Government benefits and other purposes. Hence, this Court is of the opinion that, it is just and necessary to direct the respondent to make necessary entry in the concerned register regarding date of birth of the petitioner and to issue the birth certificate after collecting necessary fee and penalty, if any. Hence, the petition deserves to be allowed. Accordingly, point under consideration is answered in the **affirmative**.

11. POINT NO.2: In view of above discussion, this Court proceeds to pass the following:

ORDER

The petition filed by the petitioners U/s 13(3) of the Registration of Births and Deaths Act, 1969 is hereby allowed.

The respondent is hereby directed to enter the date of birth of the petitioner by name **Mallappa S/o Buggappa** as 16.01.2008 born at Nasalwai village, Tq: Gurumitkal, Dist: Yadgiri in the register of birth maintained in his office, after collecting necessary fee and penalty, if any, by the petitioner.

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The petitioner is at liberty to get her birth certificate from the respondent, after necessary entry is made in view of the above order.
