. Accused No. 1 to 8 are present before the Court along with their Ld. Advocate. Accused are charge-sheeted under Section 328, 272, 273, 183 of Indian Penal Code along with Section 26(2) (iv), 27(3)(d), 26(3)(e), 30(2)(a), 3(1)(zz) 3(1) (zz) (v) punishable Section 59(1) of Food Safety and Standard Act 2006. The offence punishable under Section 328 of Indian Penal Code is exclusively triable by the Hon'ble Sessions Court. The copies of charge-sheet are supplied to accused persons in view of Section 207 of Criminal Procedure Code. The accused are represented by their lawyer. In the said crime I.O. has filed supplementary charge-sheet and that charge-sheet bearing separate number as R.C.C. No. 238 of 2023. In the said matter order passed on today and i.e. club into the present matter. The case is triable by the Hon'ble Sessions Court. Hence, it will have to be committed to the Hon'ble Court of Session, Dhule. Hence, following order.

: O R D E R :

1. The case is committed to the Hon'ble Sessions Court, Dhule.
2. Accused are directed to appear before the Hon'ble Sessions Court, Dhule on 10.05.2024.
3. The record of case be sent to the Hon'ble Sessions Court, Dhule.
4. The record of the case, the documents and articles, which are to be produced in evidence, shall be sent to the Hon'ble Sessions Court, Dhule.

5. The Police Station Officer, Police station Pimpalner be directed to produce *muddemal* property in the Hon'ble Sessions Court, Dhule on or before 10.05.2024 positively.
6. Learned A.P.P. be informed about the committal of case to the Hon'ble Sessions Court, Dhule.
