

Case called before Lok-Adalath.

After conciliation, petitioner and Respondent No.2 filed the joint memo Dated: 09-09-2023 agreeing to compromise the case.

Perused the records and joint memo, I am satisfied that the compromise entered into voluntary and the same is lawful. Therefore, the same needs to be accepted. Therefore, proceed to pass the following

ORDER

The petition filed by the petitioner U/s. 166 of M.V.Act is allowed with no order as to cost, as follows:

The petitioner shall receive and the Respondent No.2 Sri Ram **General Insurance Co., LTD, Bengaluru** shall pay a sum of **Rs.1,80,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Eighty Thousand only)** in full satisfaction of the claim, within 3 months from the date of this order, failing which the petitioner is entitled for

interest at 6% p.a. from today till the date of payment.

Since the amount awarded is meager entire amount is ordered to be released in favour of the petitioner.

The Respondent No.2 insurance company is directed to credit the amount directly to the Bank account of the claimant through RTGS/NEFT and the claimant is directed to furnish his account details at office of the Tribunal.

Draw up award accordingly.
