5. That, the following points arise for My consideration and determination.

1. Whether the plaintiffs have made out the grounds that the proposed defendants No.3 and 4 are the necessary parties to the suit?
 2. What order?
6. That, My answer to the aforesaid points are as under;

7. **Point No.1:** That, the plaintiffs have contended that, the proposed defendants No.3 and 4 are their sisters and it is very much necessary to implead them in present case.

It is to be noted here that, the proposed defendants No.3 and 4 being the sisters of the plaintiffs becomes a necessary parties to the proceedings.
