Read pursis filed by the complainant at Exh. 21. As per contents therein, the dispute between the complainant and the accused is amicably settled. The contents of pursis are voluntarily admitted by the complainant. Learned advocate Shri S. K. Patil has identified the complainant. The complainant submits that he has received the entire amount of disputed cheque. Therefore, he does not want to proceed with the case and wants to withdraw the complaint. The permission needs to be given to the complainant to withdraw the complaint under section 257 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. The complaint needs to be disposed of being withdrawn by the complainant. Milind Jagdish Bhalerao under trial accused, thereby needs to be acquitted and released forthwith. Hence, the order-

ORDER

- 1) S. C. C. 1159/2022 is disposed of being withdrawn by the complainant under section 257 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
- 2) Accused Milind Jagdish Bhalerao is acquitted from the offence punishable under section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 vide section 257 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
- 3) Accused Milind Jagdish Bhalerao – an under trial accused - be released forthwith, if not required in any other case.
- 4) The Court fees be refunded to complaint as per rule.
