1. The present order shall dispose off the bail application filed by the applicant / accused Gurwinder Singh @ Billa through counsel for allegedly committing the offence punishable under Section 303(2) of BNS.

2. The Ld. Counsel for the applicant / accused submitted that the applicant / accused has been falsely implicated in the present case and he has not committed any such offence. The Ld. Counsel further submitted that no recovery is to be effected from the applicant / accused. Hence, a prayer for releasing the accused / applicant on bail has been made.

3. On the other hand, reply by learned Addl.P.P not filed reply however the ld. APP for state contested the bail application orally by denying the averments made in the application. The Ld. APP for the State submitted that accused / applicant has committed serious offence and he is not entitled for concession of bail and prayed for the dismissal of the bail application.

4. I have heard Ld. Counsel for the applicant / accused and Ld. APP for the State and have gone through the record carefully.

5. Perusal of the papers shows that the applicant / accused is in custody since 05-06-2025. The allegations levelled against the applicant / accused are yet to be proved. Nothing is to be recovered from the applicant / accused. The presentation of challan and thereafter, conclusion of trial would take a long time and no useful purpose will be served by keeping the applicant/ accused in custody for indefinite period. Thus, keeping in view the

facts and circumstances of the present case, the applicant / accused namely Gurwinder Singh @ Billa is admitted to bail in the present case under Sections 303(2) of BNS, on his furnishing of bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 30,000/- with one surety of the like amount, subject to following conditions:-

- 1) The applicant shall appear in the Court on each and every date of hearing.
- 2) The applicant shall not interfere in the investigation or indulge himself in influencing or threatening the witnesses.
- 3) The applicant shall not leave the territory of India without the prior permission of the Court.

Requisite bail bonds not furnished. Papers be returned to the concerned court immediately.
