This petition coming on 12.03.2025 for hearing before me in the presence of Smt.Seema Raveendran, Advocate for petitioners; Public Prosecutor for the Respondent (State); the Court passed the following:-

ORDER

This petition is filed u/s.397(1) of Cr.P.C. by A1 and A2 in C.C.No.3178/2020 on the file of the Court of Judicial Magistrate of First Class -I Alappuzha, to stay further proceedings in C.C.3178/2020 till the disposal of the Revision Petition.

2. This revision petition is filed against the order passed by the trial court in C.M.P.No.318/2024 in C.C.3178/2020. The petition was filed u/s.239 of Cr.P.C. by the petitioners claiming discharge in the case. The petition was dismissed by the trial court by above said order dated 13.01.2025. Against the order the revision petition is filed. In this petition, the petitioners contended that if further proceedings in the trial court is not stayed, it will cause irreparable injuries to them. Therefore, prayed to grant stay of all proceedings in the trial court in the above stated case.

3. Heard the petitioners' counsel.

4. The petitioners herein are the accused in the trial court and their petition filed u/s.239 of CrPC was dismissed. Considering the challenge against the order of the trial court in the revision petition and other facts and circumstances of the case revealed from available records, I am of the view that for the interest of justice, stay is to be granted for further proceedings in C.C.3178/2020 in the trial court, till the disposal of the revision petition. Therefore, stay is granted in further proceedings in C.C.3178/2020 on the file of Court of Judicial Magistrate of First Class -I Alappuzha, till the disposal of the revision petition.

In the result, this petition is allowed.
