court on the same day passed the following:-

JUDGMENT

Mediation agreement is received. Matter settled between the
parties. I had gone through the agreement. It is seen that the parties
entered into the agreement voluntarily. Nothing is there to suggest
that the terms in the agreement are against public policy. Hence the

agreement is accepted. Appeal is allowed in part and the decree claim is limited to Rs.12,00,000/- (Twelve lakh). Appellant paid the entire amount to the respondent and the claim is satisfied as full and final. The mediation agreement will form part of the Judgment and decree. The court fee shall be refunded as per law.
