This case having come up for this day's proceedings, the court passed the following:-

ORDER

This petition has been filed under section 23 (2) of Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 by the aggrieved person in MC.64/2026.

2. Heard the counsel for the petitioner and perused the affidavit and documents.

3. It is satisfied that the petitioner had made out a prima facie case. In this circumstance and for reasons mentioned in the petition, the prayer can be allowed.

In the result, the petition is allowed as follows:

1. An interim exparte order is passed restraining the respondent from committing any acts of domestic violence, physically and mentally to the petitioner until further orders.
2. The interim prayer for maintenance can only been considered after appearance of the respondent and after compliance of the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Rajnesh Vs. Neha ILR 2020 (4) KER 579.
3. Forward the copy of order to SHO, North Police Station, Alappuzha for necessary assistance.
