JUDGMENT

1. This case is instituted upon the final report submitted by the State of Kerala - Police alleging commission of offence punishable U/Sec 143,147,149,283 of PUBLIC WAYS (RESTRICTION OF ASSEMBLIES AND PROCESSION) ACT, 2011 .

2. The Accused is absent. Accused pleaded guilty through counsel to the charge framed for the above said offence. I am satisfied that the plea is made voluntary. Hence the plea of the Accused is accepted. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I am satisfied that the following sentence shall meet the ends of the justice.

In the result, the Accused convicted for the offence punishable under Section 143,147,149,283 of the PUBLIC WAYS (RESTRICTION OF ASSEMBLIES AND PROCESSION) ACT, 2011 and Accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.500/-. In case of the default of the Accused in paying the said fine amount, Accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for 10 Days.

The properties produced in this case, if any, shall be disposed of as per law.
