JUDGMENT

1. This case is instituted upon the final report submitted by the State of Kerala alleging commission of offence punishable U/Sec 6 of **PUBLIC WAYS (RESTRICTION OF ASSEMBLIES AND PROCESSION) ACT, 2011** , U/Sec 143,147,149,283 of IPC \ .

2. The A1 is present. The particulars of the above said offence are read over and explained to the Accused to which Accused pleaded guilty. I am satisfied that the plea is made voluntary. Hence the plea of the Accused is accepted. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I am satisfied that the following sentence shall meet the ends of the justice.

3. In the result, the Accused A1 convicted for the offence punishable under Section 6 of the **PUBLIC WAYS (RESTRICTION OF ASSEMBLIES AND PROCESSION) ACT, 2011** and Accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.1000/- and simple imprisonment till the rising of the court. In case of the default of the Accused A1 in paying the said fine

amount, Accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for 10 Days.

Case against remaining accused A2, A3, A4, A5, A6, A7, A8, A9 is refiled with
Registration No:CC 1654/2023.
