ORDER

Heard the counsel for the plaintiff/petitioner. No caveat reportedly pending. Perused the records. The accompanying affidavit discloses a prima facie case. I am satisfied that if the notice is issued before granting the injunction, the resultant delay would defeat the purpose of granting the injunction. Further I believe that if injunction is not granted irreparable injury will be caused to the plaintiff/petitioner.

Hence, the 1st defendant and any one acting under him is restrained from committing any acts of mischief in the Plaint Schedule Property, inducting

strangers therein and from interfering with the rights of plaintiff as a co owner over the Plaint Schedule Property until further orders. Comply with Provisos (a) and (b) to Order 39 Rule 3. Issue notice to the respondent. Return of notice by 20.02.2025.
